We recognize that the change in schedules may be difficult for our students and families to navigate. Please understand that schedules were approached with the hopes of maintaining current times as much as possible; however, limits in transportation and students attending other district affiliated programs somewhat limited our approach. In general, schedules were developed that:

- Allow for district provided transportation K-12, to and from school with cleaning in between runs
- Maintain scheduling consistency for as many students as possible
- Maintain teacher relationships with students and families, in most cases
- Address developmental needs of students across different levels
- · Value both in-person and virtual learners

Secondary and elementary schools will communicate with families in greater detail regarding more specifics of the school earn expectations for the school day. Our transportation department is working on finalizing bus schedules, which we are planning to add to our district website by Friday, 2/26.

## Transition Dates for ALL Students (Virtual and In-person)

In order to best navigate the safe and effective teaching of procedures associated with transitioning students successfully to our Safe Return, we have established a "slow fill" model. Specific transition opportunities for secondary grades will be published by the buildings for students and families new to our secondary schools.
