

Board Recommendation 2018



Should enrollments continue to increase significantly over time, it is recommended that the district engage in a systematic, comprehensive, transparent and inclusive process that includes:

- Data collection enrollment trends, neighborhood composition (children), other
- Review of research educational programming and impacts
- Consider the following in the comprehensive analysis (not in priority order):
 - Grade level configurations
 - Build a new school Powell Rd; Wardcliff property
 - Open Wardcliff
 - Repurpose Edgewood
 - · Add additional classrooms to existing buildings
 - Make additional renovations to existing buildings
 - Other





Board Recommendation 2018



Recommendation – continued

- Develop models: assigning neighborhoods; consider various grade level configurations
- Develop positives, challenges and associated costs
- Engage in community conversations: educate and seek feedback

Notes:

- This process (as described above) could take up to one year before a final Board decision.
- The bond proposal and building process could take up to 2 years.
- The district may not have to engage in this process if enrollments stabilize.










Strategic Plan Survey Results








Enrollment Trends - Michigan










Enrollment Trends - Our Region

- New school buildings

- Remodeling existing school buildings
- Energy conservation improvements
- Asbestos abatement
- Land purchases
- Site development and improvements
- Athletic and PE facilities and improvements
- Playground development and improvements
- Refunding debt
- Direct bond program costs/professional fees
- School bus purchases
- Loose furnishings and equipment
- Technology hardware and initial operating system/customized applications
- Communication devices

Unallowable

- Repairs, maintenance, or maintenance agreements
- Supplies, salaries, service contracts, lease payments, installment purchase contracts
- Automobiles, trucks, or vans
- Portable classrooms for temporary use
- Uniforms
- Textbooks
- Upgrades to computer operating system/ application software
- Computer training, consulting, or maintenance contracts





Sinking Fund


- In May 2021 voters approved continuation for 10 years, generating \$1.4 Million/year
- Allowable Uses
 - Upkeep and repair of facilities
 - Site improvements
 - Energy savings projects
 - Student instructional technology
 - Security investments

TowerPinkster + The Christman Company will facilitate community engagement sessions and provide design and construction expertise as we narrow bond scope.










How are you associated with Okemos Public Schools?



We received responses from a broad range of inputs who have connections to OPS






If a parent / guardian, how many students currently enrolled in Okemos PS?



539 responses






If an Okemos PS employee, please specify your number of years of employ within the district:








Grade Level Configuration Survey


Top Benefits to the Current Grade Level Configuration Identified Include:

- Stability with current configuration


Top Concerns with the Current Grade Level Configuration Identified Include:

What areas of benefits do you find of the current K-4 to 5-6 to 7-8 to High School model?




What areas of concerns do you have with the current K-4 to 5-6 to 7-8 to High School model?




Agree or disagree with the following statement: Students and staff need consistency at school, especially during the next three to five years, so major configuration/grade level changes during that time should be limited.

Configuration Plan

- Maintain the K-4, 5-6, 7-8, 9-12 configuration model
- Consider all district facilities and properties to implement that model (build, expand, renovate, repurpose, reopen)
- Address current overcrowding and future enrollment growth
- Allow flexibility should the district wish to purse grade level reconfiguration in the future
