

Q1 Did you participate in the reproductive health classes this year? (If your answer is no, please go directly to question #8)





Q2 Did you talk to your mom or dad (or other adult) about questions you had, or about what you learned in class?





Q3 If you did not talk to your mom or dad (or other adult), why not?


















