

What do we mean by "accessibility"? By design, an accessible system gives all people access to educational experiences, information, and services. Every person is given the opportunity to acquire the same information, engage in the same interactions, and enjoy the same services without having to ask, go out of their way, or endure exceptional barriers. Examples of accessibility: A student with food allergies can access the dinner at prom without worrying about health risks because the menu has been made available prior to the event. A teacher labels every item in her classroom with its name in English to support her students who are learning English as a second language.

COMMENCEMENT: MAY 21, 2023

A MESSAGE FROM DR. KEMSLEY

DEAR OKEMOS HIGH SCHOOL FAMILIES.

AFTER MEETING WITH THE STUDENT ADVISORY GROUP, THE COUNSELING DEPARTMENT, FACULTY, AND OTHER STAKEHOLDERS, I RECOMMENDED THAT THE OKEMOS BOARD OF EDUCATION VOTE TO MOVE THE DATE OF COMMENCEMENT TO MAY 21ST. THIS DATE MORE CLOSELY ALIGNS WITH SENIORS' LAST DAY OF SCHOOL. ON NOVEMBER 28TH, THE OKEMOS BOARD OF EDUCATION APPROVED THAT RECOMMENDATION. YOU MAY BE WONDERING, WHY THE CHANGE? THAT'S A GOOD QUESTION! ALLOW ME TO PROVIDE SOME INSIGHT INTO THE RATIONALE FOR OUR RECOMMENDATION FOR THIS CHANGE.

SENIORS WORK HARD FOR FOUR YEARS OF HIGH SCHOOL. SEVERAL WEEKS BEFORE THEIR LAST DAY, COUNSELORS AND TEACHERS ARE WORKING CLOSELY WITH SENIORS TO ENSURE THEY MEET ALL OF THEIR GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS, A PROCESS CALLED SENIOR STATUS. THE PROCESS HAS SEVERAL CHECKPOINTS AND DATES WHEN WE ARE MAKING CONTACT WITH OUR STUDENTS. A FIRM DEADLINE WILL BOTH BOLSTER THE MEANING OF OUR SENIOR STATUS PROCESS AND PROVIDE CLEAR EXPECTATIONS FOR OUR STUDENTS WITHOUT AMBIGUITY.

SENIORS' LAST WEEK IS A REALLY EXCITING TIME FOR THEM. THEY PARTICIPATE IN THE SENIOR PROJECT, HAVE A PICNIC, FINISH UP ANY REMAINING ASSIGNMENTS (OF COURSE) AND PRACTICE FOR COMMENCEMENT. AFTER MEETING WITH A FOCUS GROUP OF SENIORS, THEY WERE VERY MUCH IN FAVOR OF KEEPING THIS MOMENTUM GOING WITH COMMENCEMENT THREE DAYS LATER. IT IS THE NATURAL CRESCENDO TO THAT WEEK'S ACTIVITIES AND EXCITEMENT.

FINALLY, SENIORS TOLD US A COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY MORE CLOSELY ALIGNED WITH THEIR LAST DAY WILL ALLOW THEM TO HAVE A TIMELY END TO THEIR HIGH SCHOOL EXPERIENCE AND START PLANNING AND PREPARING FOR THEIR FUTURE: OPEN HOUSES, TRAVEL, WORK, AND GETTING READY FOR COLLEGE WERE ALL TOPICS OF DISCUSSION.

REST ASSURED, WE HAVE BEEN THOUGHTFULLY PLANNING TO ENSURE WE ARE NOT INTERFERING WITH ADVANCED PLACEMENT TESTING. SIMILARLY, WE HAVE BEEN AND WILL CONTINUE TO BE MINDFUL TO PROVIDE THE PROPER SUPPORT FOR OUR STRUGGLING LEARNERS. OUR GOAL, OF COURSE, IS TO HAVE OUR KIDS PARTICIPATE IN COMMENCEMENT. THANK YOU FOR YOUR CONTINUED SUPPORT AND, AGAIN, ALLOW ME TO TAKE THIS OPPORTUNITY TO TELL YOU HOW PROUD WE ARE OF OUR STUDENTS.
