

DEI INFORMATION

The Winter Solstice occurs on December 21 at 4:48 pm EST and is the point at which the path of the sun in the sky is farthest south. At this point, the sun travels the shortest path through the sky. This results in the day of the year with the least amount of sunlight, which also gives us the year's longest night. In the days and weeks before the Winter Solstice, days become shorter and shorter. On the solstice, the Northern Hemisphere will have 8 hours and 46 minutes of daylight and then winter begins. Many cultures and Indigenous communities around the world celebrate the Winter Solstice, as it is considered by some to mark the death and rebirth of the sun. As a reminder, Okemos Public Schools has partnered with Child and Family Charities to provide a mental health clinic within Okemos High School. This opportunity is made possible because of the Expanding, Enhancing Emotional Health (E3) grant through the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services Adolescent Health Center Division. The clinic will provide on-site comprehensive mental health services from mild to moderate severity of need. There will be a full-time therapist at the OHS clinic five days a week and will be able to serve all OPS youth ages 5 to 21 years.
