The superintendent shall develop an exposure control plan which meets the requirements of federal and state law and provides information and protection to the staff of the district.

Bloodborne Pathogens - Regulations

The superintendent shall develop an exposure control plan to assist the district in protecting staff who may be exposed to bloodborne pathogens during the course of their employment. In addition, post-exposure evaluations and follow-up procedures will be developed and record-keeping procedures established which meet the requirements of OSHA 29 CFR 1910.1030.

The exposure control plan shall include:

1. An explanation and determination of what constitutes an exposure.
2. A specifically stated schedule and method of compliance with federal and state requirements.
3. A description of the forms of personal protective equipment which are available and how they shall be utilized by appropriate staff.
4. An explanation of the training to be implemented.
5. A description of how this information will be communicated with staff.
6. A description of the immunization process.
