Emergency Operations Plans

The Okemos Board of Education recognizes that there will be occasions when it is necessary to respond to emergency incidents that threaten the safety or health of students and employees, or are disruptive to the operation of a school, multiple schools, or the school system. Advanced preparation and planning minimize risks inherent in any emergency. The board of education directs the superintendent or designee to implement an emergency operations plan (EOP) for each school building that the school operates and conduct biennial reviews of the plan beginning in the 2019-2020 school year.

The EOP shall be developed in coordination with local law enforcement agencies and shall provide for emergency procedures and the coordination of management and communications in the event of an emergency. The EOP plan is designed to be used in coordination with normal management and decision making of the district, when possible.
