STUDENTS

Extra-curricular Activities

The board of education seeks to achieve as broad participation by students in extra-curricular activities as possible within limitations of budget, space and facilities and in accordance with state and federal law. Such activities shall extend and reinforce the instructional program, provide practice in democratic self-government, build positive student morale and spirit in support of the school, and provide wholesome social and recreational activities. Such activities shall include, but not be limited to, athletics, fine arts (art, drama, music), and school-related clubs.

Every effort should be made by administration and staff to enable any given student to participate in a variety of activities allowing latitude that will not exclude one activity because of participation in another.

The superintendent is responsible for the development of rules and procedures pertaining to student activities.
