INSTRUCTION

Approved Credits

High school credits shall be expressed in terms of Carnegie Units. The superintendent is responsible for a definition of the Carnegie Units as far as the amount of work required to earn such unit is concerned.

The above named credits may be earned in the regular high school program or through one or more of the following: approved correspondence study, completion of community college or university courses, credits taken abroad, summer school, on-line courses, CHAMP classes through Michigan State University; other programs approved by the superintendent; or by means of the Home Bound Teaching Program for children who are certified by a physician as unable to attend school.
