Okemos High School Spanish Teacher Karen Sanders presented information regarding a student trip to Ecuador. The trip is proposed for June 16 – June 25, 2020 and is a cultural and language experience. It was emphasized that all school rules and policies will be applied at all times while abroad.

Student Trip

Superintendent Hood reported on the following: Strategic Planning process activities including upcoming meetings and a survey sent to families, staff, alumni and residents; student enrollment update and a projected increase of 86 students; upcoming presentation regarding M-Step and PSAT assessment results; student representatives to the board; and an upcoming discussion regarding the current status of the State's budget and what various options would mean for the district.

Superintendent Report

Mr. Hood also presented preliminary plans for the Bennett Woods expansion, including rerouting the bus and car lines, additional parking, the addition of classrooms and a multipurpose room. Next steps were described and include soliciting request for bids for board action.

Assistant Superintendent Bailey provided a brief world language update including the need to pursue new opportunities and expand partnerships.

Members inquired about Latin; online enrollment in world languages; and the impact on the district's budget when the State has not finalized its own.
