The program offered resources on how to handle or deal with sexual abuse and online predators. The organization uses "red flag scenarios", where a situation is described to students and the student(s) explain why it's a red flag and how to handle a red flag situation. The program also offers a brief review of contraception and STIs including the categories of STIs.
