- ❖ Headphones or earbuds to keep at school—**label with your name**. Put inside a Ziploc bag with your name on the bag.
- ❖ 1 Plastic Pencil Box **OR** Pencil Pouch
- ❖ Scissors
- ❖ Sharpened #2 Pencils (no mechanical pencils)
- ❖ Eraser
- ❖ Small manual pencil sharpener with a lid to catch shavings
- ❖ Crayons (16 to 24 Pack)
- ❖ Colored Pencils (12 to 24 Pack)
- ❖ Washable Markers (10-12 Pack)
- ❖ Dry Erase Markers (4 pack)
- ❖ Glue Sticks
